From Madison, take I-90/94/39 North 25 miles. Take the exit 108 onto I-39 toward Portage/Wausau. After about 75 miles take exit 161 for US-51 Bus toward Stevens Point. You will be entering Stevens Point from the North. Merge onto Division St for 1 mile. Turn right onto Franklin St and proceed 0.9 mile to Pfiffner Park which will be on your left.

Course Description

¼ Marathon 10K (6.5 mi) Trail rating 2
½ Marathon 21K (13.1 mi) Trail rating 2
Marathon 42K (26.2 mi) Trail rating 2

This walk with three distance options will be on the Green Circle Trail system in and around Portage County's urban area.

REGISTRATION

There will be no pre-registration for this Volksmarch. **However all participants must pre-register for the primary Walk Wisconsin event.**
