### Verona Walk - Saturday, May 21 By Kristi Kenyon

Our next traditional walk is the Verona walk scheduled for Saturday May 21. The walk will start and finish at Hometown Junction Shelter located along Main Street south of Verona Ave. at the intersection of Main Street and Railroad St in Verona.

This walk features two loops. The 6k West Loop features the Military Ridge State Trail, the new Verona Area High School, and residential streets. The West Loop qualifies for Little Free Library, Rails to Trails, and Walk with America's Veterans special programs.

The 5k East Loop features a different section of the Military Ridge State Trail, Hometown USA Community Park, the Ice Age Trail, Badger Prairie County Park, the Verona Public Library, and the historic Matts House. The East Loop qualifies for the Town Hall/City Hall special program in addition to the Little Free Library, Rails to Trails, and Walk with America's Veterans programs.

The walk is primarily on bike paths, city sidewalks, and streets, with a short section on Ice Age Trail grass path.

Hometown Junction Shelter is located at the intersection of Main Street and Railroad St in Verona. Use address 101 W. Railroad St. A parking lot is available on Railroad Street adjacent to the shelter. Restrooms are available at the shelter.

Start any time 8 AM to noon and finish by 3 PM. \$3 for all walkers.

# Walk the Only Waunakee in The World - Saturday, June 25 By Don Suloff

With the weather finally warming up, we will enjoy a diverse walk in Waunakee on June 25, 2022. Registration will be at the Village Park Gazebo on Division Street just south of Hwy 19 in Waunakee and will be open between 8 am and noon. All walkers need to have completed their walks no later than 3 pm. There is ample parking on the west side of Division Street. To reach the start point from the north or east, take Hwy 19 west and turn left on Division just before entering Waunakee. When coming from the south or west, take Hwy 19 east and turn right on Division just after leaving Waunakee.

Walks of 10k and 6k will be offered with the walks being unique from one another. The 10k walk will include the Waunakee Area Veterans Memorial, a new development and school on the east side of Waunakee, a modern covered bridge, and Castle Creek Conservancy. The 6k walk will include a loop through St John's Cemetery, the historic St John the Baptist Catholic Church, several lovely local parks, and the Waunakee Area Veterans Memorial.

The walk showcases much of the campus including Alumni Park, Bascom Hill, and Camp Randall. The 10k walk includes a long stretch on the Lakeshore Path and Allen Centennial Gardens as well.

## Word From Some of Your Walk Box POCs (Points of Contact) Compiled By Jerry Wilson

#### Appleton, By Pete Nagan

The Appleton Walk Box hotel location has been rebranded as the Hilton Appleton Paper Valley with the same driving directions and start point as before.

#### Capital - Madison, By Jerry Wilson

The Capital Walk Box has been relocated to a new home at The Concourse Hotel, 1 W. Dayton Street, Madison. To locate the walk box without assistance, walk past the hotel front desk and start along a hallway with a staircase on your right-side. The box is being kept, in plain sight, under a podium permanently stored on your left-side before you reach the back hallway. A sitting area is located behind you as you face the walk box storage area. Restrooms and water are located in the back hallway to the right as you enter the back hall, near the hotel bar named The Bar. Walk directions in the box have been temporarily amended to begin at the new start box location, soon new directions will be loaded to the box.

#### De Forest. By Mary Liebig

De Forest walkers using Frequent Walker Coupons will now be able to leave them and their start cards in an envelope/folder in the walk box as we are currently able to do for all other local Dane County walks. Please don't leave cash or checks in the walk box though!

#### Milwaukee. By Jerry Wilson

The Milwaukee walk box continues to be available at the front desk on the Milwaukee Residence Inn, 648 Plankinton Avenue. Earlier route concerns due to construction in the area determined that construction will affect walkers no different than recent years. Walkers using their common sense deal with construction all summer long.

#### Neenah, By Pete Nagan

The Neenah 10K features a new route that takes walkers past Neenah's historic 19th century mansions, along a new trail next to Lake Winnebago, and through Riverside Park before connecting with the "Loop the Little Lake" trail circling around Little Lake Buttes Des Morts for the second half of the walk.
