Visit Switzerland in Wisconsin - New Glarus Walk - Saturday, July 23 By Don Suloff

Enjoy the sites and atmosphere of New Glarus, settled by Swiss immigrants in 1845, on our July 23 rd walk. We will register at the gazebo in Village Park on 4th Avenue just off Railroad Street from 8 am to noon, with all walkers requested to be back by 3 pm. There is ample parking along 4th . To reach the start point, follow Hwy 69 to New Glarus and turn west on 6 th Avenue. Turn right on Railroad St. and then left on 4th to the gazebo.

The 5k walk is a subset of the 10k walk, and both walks will qualify for the Little Free Libraries, Rails to Trails, Rockin' Around the Clock, Town Halls, and Veterans Walks special programs. 
