Wednesday Morning Group Walks at East & West Towne Malls - January and February

Sometimes it's harder to walk outside in winter due to snow, ice, and cold. In the Madison area, we're lucky to have two large indoor malls at East and West Towne to walk in with perfect weather! Whether it's connecting with other walkers, listening to music or a podcast, or shopping and browsing, it's good to get out of the house and get some exercise at the mall. Both malls open at 10 a.m. on weekdays.

Karen Reger and Mike Roy have volunteered to help the Dairyland Walkers meet and register to walk at East Towne (Karen) and West Towne (Mike) malls on alternating Wednesday mornings in January and February. They'll be assisting walkers at 10 a.m. in the Food Court on the dates listed below. If driving conditions are poor, they may not be at the mall on these dates. Others are free to walk on these dates though and register and "stamp" for credit on another walking date.

Meet inside at the Food Court of each mall at 10 a.m. to register and start walking. There is a \$3 fee for all participants, and both mall walks will count for AVA credit. Frequent Walker Coupons can be used for the West Towne mall walk. A 5k (3 mile) walk is 4.5 laps around the mall, 10k (6 miles) is 9 laps around the mall.

February 8, 2023 Membership Meeting - Held Via Zoom**By Doug Wiest****Dr. Franklin Stein to be speaker at the February 2023 Dairyland Walkers membership meeting**

Our speaker for the 8 February 2023 membership meeting, which will be held via ZOOM beginning at 6:30PM Central Standard Time, is Dr. Franklin Stein. Dr. Stein has been practicing Occupational Therapy for more than 60 years and will present a briefing titled "Self Regulation and Healthy Aging".

Dr. Stein is a native of Brooklyn, New York, and has a Bachelor's degree in Psychology from Brooklyn College in New York, a Master's degree in Occupational Therapy from New York University, and a Ph.D. in Psychology from New York University. His resume includes teaching at Boston University; Director of Occupational Therapy and chair of the Health Science Department at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee; Director of the School of Medical Rehabilitation at the University of Manitoba in Winnipeg; and professor of Occupational Therapy at the University of South Dakota, from where he retired and remains professor emeritus. After retirement, he moved to Madison in 2002. He is the founding editor of the journal Occupational Therapy International; founding editor of Annals of International Occupational Therapy; and has written numerous books on occupational therapy. He has traveled worldwide giving lectures on occupational therapy, most recently in Brazil in 2019, before the Corona pandemic hit.
